FADES TO BLACK:

Title Sequence: "TURNING TIDES" with Amy's and Matt's symbols becoming part of the title.

INT. AMY'S DORM ROOM - MORNING

Surprised. Matt raises his right hand to look, but his doesn't match Amy's.

DISSOLVE TO:
